Engineering

The Faculty of Engineering is the oldest department at the University of Pannonia. It includes a variety of practice-oriented disciplines responding to the needs of the modern world, for example, those oriented at environmental protection or developing water operation technologies. The Faculty is considered one of the most prestigious engineering institutes in Hungary due to its dynamic and modern teaching approach, combining new educational methods with the values of classical engineering education. Well-equipped laboratories and the internationally recognised research center allow students to participate in R&D&I activities in different spheres, such as bio, environmental and chemical engineering, bio-nanotechnology and technical chemistry research, natural science, mechatronics. Besides, the chemical courses on the faculty are accredited by the Institution of Chemical Engineers (IChemE). Therefore, the chemical engineering degrees (BSc and MSc) obtained here are accepted in the Commonwealth countries and the United States.

For example, our students can be involved in cyber defense research, healthcare-related research and development and supply chain management research.

Zalaegerszeg

Veszprém

Exciting traditional events of the university, such as Freshmen's Ball, Faculty Parties and the University Days of Veszprém (a week-long competition of student teams with parties and concerts), are all held on Veszprém campus.

The campus is located between the capital of Hungary Budapest and Lake Balaton – the second most visited tourist attraction of the country. Surrounded by Bakony Hills, the city provides both a lively and vibrant cultural life and calm environment to focus on study and professional development.

STUDENT SERVICES



Student union (PEHÖK)

Student union of the University of Pannonia is responsible for representing the interests of current and future students in different university-related matters, both at the regional and national levels. The student union cooperates with other student communities and takes an active part in organizing sport, cultural and social activities in the university.



Mentor programme

Mentor programme was created to help our students easily accommodate in the new country. Upon request, a student gets connected with a Hungarian and an international mentor even before coming to Hungary. Mentors are students themselves, and they are happy to answer any questions about the university and the city and assist newcomers with different kinds of issues, such as administrative processes and paperwork. Besides, many exciting intercultural events

are organized within the mentor programme; they include board games, movie nights, picnics and trips. Therefore, participation in the mentor programme is an opportunity to easily adapt to the new international environment, make new friends and learn more about Hungary and the cultures of each other.



Healthcare services

The University of Pannonia cares about the health and well-being of all students and aims to provide them with the necessary medical support throughout their study. On campus, there are the offices of an English-speaking doctor and an English-speaking dentist, which are located in the walking distance from the dormitories and university buildings. Besides, the students of the University of Pannonia are able to request a psychological consultation, which is free of charge and confidential. Understanding the difficulties of staying in a foreign country, the university aims to create comfortable conditions for all students and provide high-quality medical and counseling services, so that students can enjoy their international experience to the full extent.



SCHOLARSHIPS

Our university has four types of scholarships. At the University of Pannonia, the following international scholarships are available. In case you are interested in any of them, please contact the International Office.

Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship



The Hungarian Diaspora Scholarship was established by the Hungarian Government for those who live in a Hungarian diaspora outside of Europe and wish to study at a Hungarian higher education institution to develop their personal, professional and cultural relations to Hungary.

Stipendium Hungaricum



The Stipendium Hungaricum scholarship holders have an opportunity to not only receive high-quality education in the heart of Europe but also experience an exciting student life in an intercultural environment. Besides, two-way mobility allows Hungarian students to spend a part of their study period in partner countries.

Provisions covered by the scholarship:

- Tuition-free education – exemption from the payment of tuition fee
- Monthly stipend – non-degree, bachelor's, master's and one-tier master's level
- Accommodation contribution – free dormitory place or a contribution to accommodation costs
- Medical insurance – health care services according to the relevant Hungarian legislation

Stipendium Hungaricum Dissertation Scholarship

The duration of the Stipendium Hungaricum Dissertation Scholarship starts in the month following the last month of the semester in which the doctoral student obtains their absolutorium and lasts for the number of awarded months, but no later than the calendar month of the public defense of the thesis. The maximum duration of the SH dissertation scholarship is 8 months.

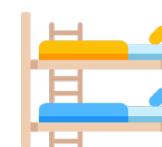
Pannónia Scholarship Programme

Student life

- **University Days of Veszprém:** The country's first ever University Days series takes place every two years, with 4 teams competing against each other and putting on a high quality show. The event concludes with the election of the Student Rector.
- **Freshers' Ball:** The Freshers' Ball is an event where the first-year students of the University get together in their prom dresses and have some fun. Every year there is a concert in this event.

Since the university is located in the Lake Balaton region, you can easily get in touch with nature, you and your friends can go hiking or you can enjoy a sunny day at the beach.

Pannon Community Hub

In the Veszprém-Balaton 2023 European Capital of Culture programme, openness and community organisation are of particular importance. In addition to an innovative spirit, sustainability is also a priority in order to preserve traditions that embody local values and the quality of life of future generations. The Pannon Community Hub is a privileged venue for this activity, where university self-organising groups can share their diverse programmes and activities with secondary school students or even interested pensioners. By supporting and strengthening the university communities, a generational bridge can be built that will bring new value to the whole community of Veszprém, involving them in the fresh and exemplary spirit of young university life.

Sport Life

Students can choose from nearly 50 types of training (such as, basketball, football, handball and volleyball), in addition to the theoretical courses offered by the Institute of Physical Education and Sport. The Institute places great emphasis on ensuring that everyone can find the right form of exercise for their level of fitness.

The university has rowing, volleyball, basketball and futsal teams, which students can join and participate in the HUCNC (Hungarian University and College National Championships).

Brick Zone

The renovated gym is open for both students and visitors of the university, offering students discounted entrance and seasonal ticket prices. Students can also complete their compulsory physical education here. With a cardio room - rowing and running machines and a skierg (ski simulator), crossfit corner, refurbished exercise machines, sauna, massage and buffet, we wait for those who wish to do some sport or recharge their batteries after a day of sport.



DORMITORIES

Magister Dormitory

Magister Dormitory is the newest dormitory located in the upper campus, two minutes away from the Faculty of Humanities and the university library. Students stay in 2-bed or 2x2-bed blocks with bathrooms in each room / block. All rooms are comfortable and cozy, with modern furniture, a small refrigerator and a microwave. On the ground floor, there is a buffet with a wide choice for drinks and snacks. An exciting thing about Magister Dormitory is that most of the dorm parties, such as Harvest party, Halloween and Christmas celebration, are held there, so you will never miss the fun! And for those, who would like to focus on studying, the dormitory offers quiet study rooms on each floor.

Central Dormitory

Central Dormitory is the first hall of residence of the university district, which is located in the lower campus, with the nearest grocery shop just around the corner! Here you can live in 2x3-bed blocks; between the rooms in each block, there is a common area with a dining table,



a cupboard and a refrigerator. Bathrooms and kitchens are located on each floor. An amazing feature of the dormitory is a special lounge area in each hallway, with comfortable chairs, small tables and a TV - there you can always find students hanging out together after a busy study day. Besides, the dormitory has a nice barbeque area, which is popular among our students during the warm season. Dormitory of Nagykanizsa

The dormitory of the University Center is located in a residential area really close to the city centre of Nagykanizsa.
